Smart Irrigation Controller — Up to \$400 rebate

A smart irrigation controller is an automatic irrigation controller that uses weather data (temperature, precipitation, humidity, solar radiation) or soil moisture, and inputs such as soil type and plant type to automatically adjust irrigation schedules according to actual plant need. Studies suggest irrigation savings of about 20 percent or more can be expected.

Actual savings is dependent on previous watering habits and weather, but a reasonable range is 10 to 30 percent. It can also reduce runoff by more than 50 percent. Local suppliers who specialize in the sale of irrigation equipment generally either carry or can order these devices. They are also called “weather-based” or “ET” controllers.

It is strongly recommended that a smart irrigation controller be installed by a qualified professional following a thorough evaluation of both the landscape and sprinkler system.

PROGRAM RULES, REGULATIONS AND APPLICATION

Please note eligibility requirements for each rebate listed below:

- Please read all rules for each rebate before purchasing and installing any equipment.
- Purchases must be made between Jan. 1, 2009 and Dec. 31, 2009. Purchases prior to Jan. 1, 2009 do not qualify. Rebate applications must be postmarked by Dec. 31, 2009. Customers who make purchases in December 2009 have until Jan. 31, 2010 to submit their applications, provided funding still exists.
- Rebate participant must be a Colorado Springs Utilities business water customer and equipment must be installed in the Colorado Springs Utilities service area.
- Account must be current and non-delinquent (i.e. no past due balances) at the time the rebate application is processed. No rebates will be given to customers whose accounts are delinquent.
- The qualified equipment must be new and for primary use at a business located in the specified Colorado Springs Utilities service area.
- For all rebates, the purchase cost of a product is the only cost that is eligible for a rebate. Some of the costs that are not rebated include, but are not limited to, installation/labor, tax, and delivery.
- Rebates are issued as a credit applied to the Colorado Springs Utilities service account and take six to eight weeks to process.
- Incomplete applications, worksheets and those lacking a copy of the purchase receipt(s) with qualifying product documentation will be denied.
- Installation site is subject to inspection by Colorado Springs Utilities staff.
- If a property for which a rebate has been issued is found on inspection not to have the qualifying product, the amount rebated will be charged back to the Colorado Springs Utilities account which was originally credited.
- Rebates are offered on a first come, first serve basis and subject to availability of funds.
- This program is for retrofit application only, and does not apply to new construction.
- All applicants must provide an acceptable form of identification to receive a rebate. The acceptable forms of identification are:
 - Colorado Driver's License
 - Colorado ID card
 - U.S. Military ID card
 - U.S. Military dependent ID card
 - U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card
 - Native American Tribal Document
