2009 COMMERCIAL RESTROOM REBATES

The 2009 Commercial Restroom Rebates are available all year (while funds last). We offer many ways to help save money on your utilities bill, conserve energy and water in our community, and put some money back in your pocket!

Program rules, regulations and application

Please note eligibility requirements for each rebate listed below:

High Efficiency Toilet Rebate Up to \$125 Rebate

Installing a High Efficiency Toilet (HET) can make a big difference in your water conservation efforts.

High Efficiency Toilets use between 1.1 and 1.28 gallons per flush. A rebate of up to \$125 per toilet is offered to existing commercial customers who retrofit their existing low flow toilets (2.3 gallons per flush) or high flow toilets (5.5 gallons per flush) with qualified WaterSense high efficiency toilets. The rebate amount cannot exceed the actual cost of the toilet. Visit www.csu.org for the approved list of toilets.

High Efficiency Urinal Rebate Up to \$75 Rebate

Installing a High Efficiency Urinal (HEU) can make a big difference in your water conservation efforts.

High Efficiency Urinals use less than 0.5 gallons per flush. A rebate of up to \$75 per urinal is offered to existing commercial customers who retrofit their existing low flush urinals (1.0 gallons per flush), intermediate flush urinals (2.5 gallons per flush) or high flush urinals (3.5 gallons per flush) with

qualified high efficiency urinals. The rebate amount cannot exceed the actual cost of the urinals. Visit www.csu.org for the approved list of urinals.

- Please read all rules for each rebate before purchasing and installing any appliance.
- Old toilets cannot be reused. Participants agree to destroy or disable their old toilets. We encourage recycling, if possible.
- Toilet purchase must include bowl and tank.
- A limit of 20 rebates per customer.
- Purchases must be made between Jan. 1, 2009 and Dec. 31, 2009. Purchases prior to Jan. 1, 2009 do not qualify. Rebate applications must be postmarked by Dec. 31, 2009. Customers who make purchases in December 2009 have until Jan. 31, 2010 to submit their applications, provided funding still exists.
- Rebate participant must be a Colorado Springs Utilities commercial water customer and appliance must be installed in the Colorado Springs Utilities service area.
- Account must be current and non-delinquent (i.e. no past due balances) at the time the rebate application is processed. No rebates will be given to customers whose accounts are delinquent.
- The qualified appliance and/or materials must be new and for primary use at a business located in the specified Colorado Springs Utilities service area.



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- For all rebates, the purchase cost of a product is the only cost that is eligible for a rebate. Some of the costs that are not rebated include, but are not limited to, installation/labor, tax, and delivery.
- Rebates are issued as a credit applied to the Colorado Springs Utilities service account and take six to eight weeks to process.
- Incomplete applications, worksheets and those lacking a copy of the purchase receipt(s) with qualifying product documentation will be denied.
- Installation site is subject to inspection by Colorado Springs Utilities staff.
- If a property for which a rebate has been issued is found on inspection not to have the qualifying product, the amount rebated will be charged back to the Colorado Springs Utilities account which was originally credited.
- Rebates are offered on a first come, first serve basis and subject to availability of funds.
- Unless otherwise stated, rebates are limited to one per customer every three years (per specific product rebate offer).
- All applicants must provide an acceptable form of identification to receive a rebate. The acceptable forms of identification are:
 - Colorado Driver's License
 - Colorado ID card
 - U.S. Military ID card
 - U.S. Military dependent ID card
 - U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner card
 - Native American Tribal Document

Steps to receive a rebate:

- Review rules and requirements as shown on this page.
- Purchase and install the qualifying product as shown on this form or from the approved list at www.csu.org.
- Return completed application form/worksheet and a copy of legible purchase receipts to:
