Dear Net Metering Customer,

In compliance with the Colorado Code of Regulations 4 CCR 723-3, Sections 3650-3699, Colorado Springs Utilities (CSU) allows customers the ability to produce their own power through renewable energy sources up to 120% of their usage, with the excess kilowatt-hours carried forward from month to month and credited at a ratio of 1:1 against the customer's retail kilowatt hour consumption in subsequent months. CSU also compensates customers for any accrued excess kilowatt-hour credits at the end of each calendar year at the Renewable Energy Net Metering Tariff rate.

Revisions to the Colorado Code of Regulations have added the following with regard to the calendar year payout:

*3664. Net Metering.*

*... the customer may make a one-time election, in writing, on or before the end of a calendar year, to request that the excess kilowatt-hours be carried forward as a credit from month to month indefinitely until the customer terminates service with the investor owned QRU, at which time no payment shall be required from the investor owned QRU for any remaining excess kilowatt hour credits supplied by the customer.*

This revision is not a mandate for municipalities, but Colorado Springs Utilities would like to offer this option to its Net Metering customers.
